2/17 Reports from Councillors -

- 2/17.1 Village Defibrillator The Defibrillator has been up and running for a year now and has not yet been used. It is still being regularly checked and is still working and the light in the kiosk has been fixed. Councillors Raine and Anderson have also volunteered to help look after it and will attend training being held by Brotherton Parish Council who are in the process of purchasing one. Hillam Parish Council have also now purchased a Defibrillator through the Community Heartbeat Trust.
- 2/17.2 Village Hall Purchase update The purchase of the village hall by Burton Salmon Village Hall Trust has not yet been completed because of undue delays caused by both sets of solicitors and the Methodist's valuer. A meeting with all parties is to be arranged as a matter of urgency to try and resolve the problems and finalise the purchase.
- 2/17.3 Burial Committee Reported that it has been a satisfactory year with some wall maintenance been completed. A comparison of charges against others in the area indicated that they were on the low side so they have been increased. The outcome of the Selby Local Plan is awaited. The Burial Committee are holding their AGM next week.
- 2/17.4 Planning The Parish Council have not raised any objections to planning applications this year. The biggest consultation has been on the development of a gas fire power station at Eggborough. The development of the Beech Grove Garage Area has not yet been decided and the issue of Caravans on land of Rawfield Lane has yet to be fully resolved. There have been no further consultation from SDC on the Selby Local Plan.
- 2/17.5 Finances The 2016/17 Receipts and Payments Account reports an in year surplus of £1.2k, and funds to carry forward of £7.5k. There was no expenditure incurred in year on Christmas expenses, street light repairs, website costs or plants.
