

**Communication to residents within close proximity to Burton Salmon
Community Primary School and / or the Main Street / New Lane / Ledgate Lane
Junction on behalf of Burton Salmon Parish Council**

7th February 2020

Dear Resident,

We are aware that there are parking issues ‘in and around’ the school and on the main village junction associated with existing resident parking and drop off / pick up parking during peak school times.

We wanted to contact you to make you aware that we are working closely with the School and the local police to improve the situation and resolve the issues accordingly.

In November we contacted all parents and carers to remind them of the purpose of the road markings in place, and what is acceptable in terms of parking distances in and around the junction.

In addition, we have advised that if the issue persists we will be working with residents going forward to deal with repeat offenders.

As such, we ask that if you witness any road traffic offences to photograph the vehicle involved noting the time and date and send this information to

Please note that these should not be sent directly to the Parish Council. Once the police have evidence of the-repeat offenders, they have advised that they will undertake personal visits to address the situation.

This includes driveways being obstructed directly. Note that if people are parking adjacent to driveways (i.e. on the opposite side of the road) and you are still having issues accessing your driveway, this is not an offence, but one that should be addressed directly with North Yorkshire Council Council’s highways team. It may be that it is appropriate to request yellow lines in these areas.
